Register Early!

Braintree Farmers' Market (BFM) vendor commitment will total approximately 30 farms/artisans. Vendors will be selected on a case-by-case basis by the quality of products and how they complement the market. The deadline for applications and space payments is April 15th, 2026. Braintree Health Dept. online Temporary Food Permit Applications must be submitted through the online portal at: <https://braintreema.gov/227/Online-Permitting> by May 13th, 2026. The Town of Braintree's temporary food permit fee is separate from the Braintree Farmers' Market fee. For example, those who are looking for a one-day temporary food permit will still need to fill out the BFM application and be charged a fee of \$60 dollars.

The Braintree Farmers' Market will be located at:
Braintree Town Hall Mall, One JFK Memorial Drive (Washington Street), Braintree, MA 02184

Time & Dates:

Braintree Farmers Market will be held each Saturday morning from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, *rain or shine*, beginning June 13, 2026 and ending October 10, 2026 with a Thanksgiving Holiday Market on November 21, 2026, for a total of nineteen (19) Saturdays for the 2026 season. Braintree Farmers Market, Inc. will provide an on-site Market Manager and Cashier for Market Moolah for each week the market is held. The Market Manager will be on site starting at 7:30 am for market set up.

Site Options:

- 10' x 10' @ \$35 per week/\$665 Full Season (Deposit: \$333)
- 10' x 20' @ \$70 per week/\$1330 Full Season (Deposit: \$665)
- 10' x 30' @ \$105 per week/\$1995 Full Season (Deposit: \$998)

Pay in full by April 15, 2026 and take a 10% discount.

Refund Policy: No refunds will be issued.

Visiting Vendors:
